


Third session was done by Dr. Shraddha Pol on preparation for breast feeding during pregnancy & delivery She explaine about Regular breast chekups, massage techniques.

# Green Corridor

- It Can reduce the total transfer time by 60-70%
- As per the latest government statistics, 17 people die each day waiting for an organ transplant.
- · There are two main reasons for this:
  - · The hesitation of people to donate their organs
  - · Lack of provisions to deliver organs to the patient's destination
- There is only a time duration of four hours between which the harvesting and transplant of the organ must be done.
- In small cities and towns, this target can still be achieved, but in cities like Mumbai, Bangalore, Delhi, etc., which are busy on roads, may not be able to fulfil this requirement.
- Thus, with a Green Corridor in every city, a lot of time can be saved in transferring the organ to the destination via traffic-free routes for the ambulance.
















Welcome address of guest speaker by Ms. Neshwari Fernando, and felicitation of both the speaker done by Ms Nikhita Logade and Ms. Tejasvi Pawaskar. 1st speaker Mr. Surajkumar kumbhar introduce the session regarding women health where he introduces his new brand of sanitary napkin- stayfine. He explained regarding importance of use of correct pad. He mentioned that materials used for the stayfine napkin is safe for women health and also ecofriendly. He describes that the materials used for stayfine is fully cotton whereas material used for other napkins are waste recycle materials such as newspaper. Each napkin is embedded with an anion chip that brings host of benefits, most notably of which are: prevents bacteria during menstruation, reduces feminine discomfort and eliminates unwanted Odors. Upon getting in contact with moisture, the Anion chip in pads releases negative ions that lets us experience the benefits. 2<sup>nd</sup> session taken by mrs. Mohini poojary where she focused on importance of using stayfine which will make the women free from all menstrual illness such as dysmenorrhea, PCOD, backache, irritability etc. She also demonstrates and compare the efficiency of stayfine with other sanitary pads which shows results of long last usage and dryness. Also shows that it has more soaking capacity of fluid than other pads. A video was shown which advertised the importance of use of stayfine sanitary pad. After the seminar there was interaction session where queries and doubts of the students were cleared by speakers. At the end, the session was adjoined by vote of thanks by ms. Greeshma Minesh.
