It is notified to all concerned that the University has prescribed following syllabus for Bachelor of Science (Nursing) course, which is made applicable by the University for all students admitted w.e.f. Academic Year 2021-2022 & onwards,

02) PERIOD OF TRAINING:

The student shall have to undergo study for a period of Four years' program comprising of eight semesters that is credit and semester based. The maximum period is complete the full course successfully shall not exceed 08 Years.

03) ATTENDANCE:

The candidate must have minimum 80% attendance (irrespective of any kind of absence) in Theory and Practical separately in each course/subject to be eligible to appear for examination.

Further the candidate must have to complete 100% attendance in each of the practical areas before award of degree. It is responsibility of the concerned College to submit 100% attendance completion certificate of the student to the University.

04) SCHEDULE OF EXAMINATIONS:

07) Passing Head and Standard of Passing:

- 1) Minimum pass marks shall be 40% (P grade/4 point) for English only and elective modules.
- 2) Minimum pass marks shall be 50% in each of the Theory and practical papers separately except in English.
- 3) A candidate has to pass in theory and practical exam separately in each of the paper.
- 4) The Student has to pass in all Mandatory modules placed within courses and the pass mark for each module shall be 50% (C Grade). The allotted percentage of marks will be included in the internal assessment of College/University Examination (Refer Appendix 2).
- 5) If a candidate fails in either theory or practical, he/she has to re-appear for both in Theory and Practical in next examination.

- 6) The candidate has to pass separately in internal and external examination which shall be reflected in the marks sheet. No institution shall submit average internal marks of the Students not more than 75% (i.e. if 40 students are admitted in a course the average score of the 40 students shall not exceed 75% of total internal marks.)
- 7) At. least 50% of the Non-nursing subjects like Applied Anatomy & Physiology Applied Biochemistry, Applied Psychology & Sociology, Applied Microbiology, Pharmacology, Genetics, Nutrition & Dietetics, Communicative English and Health/Nursing Informatics & Technology should be taught by the Nursing teachers. Teachers who are involved in teaching non-nursing subjects can be the examiners for the program.

ASESSMENT GUIDELINES

1. Grading of Performance

Based on the performance, each student shall be awarded a final grade at the end of the semester for each course. Absolute grading is used by converting the marks to grade, based on predetermined class intervals.
