This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) entered on this day of 30th October, 2018 between Seva Mandal Education Society's College of Nursing, registered with the office of Charity Commissioner, Mumbai, Maharashtra having its registered office at 338, R.A.Kidwai Road, Matunga (East), Mumbai - 400 019 (hereinafter referred to as SMES) and National Deceased Donor Transplantation network (NDTN), Mumbai having its registered office at LTMG Hospital, Room No. A/29, New College Building, Sion (West), Mumbai- 400 022. (hereinafter referred to NDTN) of the first part

Directorate Medical Education and Research (DMER) having its registered office at Govt. Dental College & Hospital Building, St. George's Hospital Compound, Near CST, Mumbai - 400 001. (hereinafter referred to as DMER) of the second part.

1. Where as Seva Mandal Education Society (SMES) and National Deceased Donor Transplantation Network (NDTN) has approached the Directorate Medical Education and Research (DMER) for permanent affiliation of the Transplant Co-ordinator Certificate Course. SMES CON has excellent infrastructure with the state of art equipment i.e. smart classroom & laboratories in its campus. College will engage service of the expertise in the respective field of organ transplantation.

2. Since the longevity and human life is of utmost importance, organ donation and its transplantation becomes essential mile stone Taking health technology into consideration, the vast gap between the demand and supply of the availability of the human organs for transplantation especially in Indian scenario (around 6000 people die daily waiting for organ transplant), SMES College of Nursing has taken a lead to establish a certificate course of "Transplant Co-ordinator".

The purpose of the course is to create general awareness about organ donation, understand the comprehensive aspects of the organ transplant i.e. physical, social, economical, ethical, emotional, psychological, moral & legal aspects.

Registered professional nurses are often the primary care givers for patients approaching the final stage of life. In order to facilitate the process of organ or tissue donation by educating / guiding the donor families, the empathetic support, counseling & guidance are the major tasks for the coordination of the complete process.

3. Seva Mandal Education Society's College of Nursing and National deceased donor transplantation network (NDTN), Mumbai in collaboration with the Director of Medical Education & Research (DMER) will conduct 6 day certificate course on the 'Transplant Co-ordinator' periodically 3 times a year or as the need arises in future.

4. The entire expenditure of the course will be borne through the income generated from the fees collected from delegates.

5. From the government, eligible candidates will be deputed for the said course regularly on permanent basis in future.

6. The DMER logo will be printed on the certificate and banner of the said course.

7. The intake capacity for the course will be 50 candidates.

8. The course details

Duration – 6 days

Timing – 9.00 am to 5.00 pm.




