- d) The MOU may be amended, renewed and terminated mutually by the institutions. In case of termination of the MOU before time, either institute shall reserve the right to terminate this MOU, by giving a written notice of not less than 30 days to the other institute.

### **Confidentiality:**

The Institutions entering into the MOU shall agree to hold in confidence all information/data/ records obtained by either of them during the conduction or performance of the programme and shall not disclose any of the material facts relating to the MOU to any third party. Violation of the confidentially will hold the MOU to be Null and Void.

### **Coordinators:**

The responsibility for organizing and conduction of this programme in harmonious and flexible manner shall be of the Coordinators of school of Nursing and hospital.
