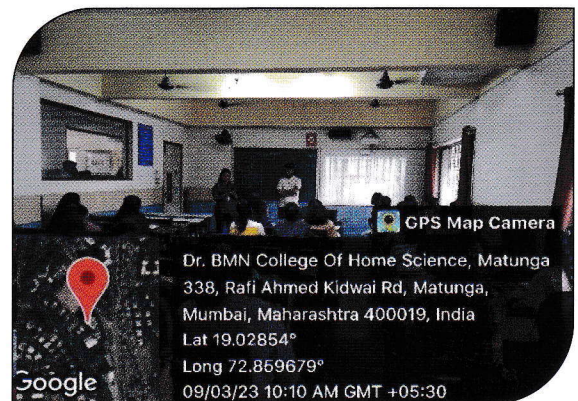

SMT. KAMALABEN GAMBHIRCHAND SHAH STAFF WELFARE FUND

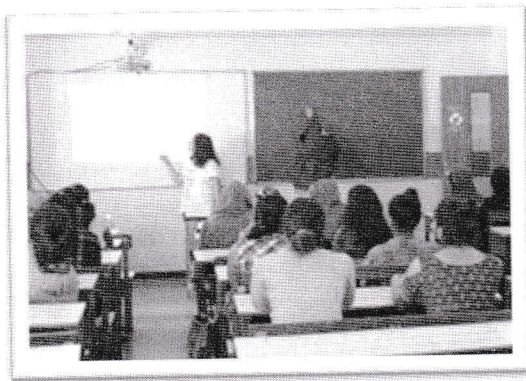

In an era where educational technology is replacing the traditional chalk and board approach, the most cutting-edge teaching tool is the SMART Board which offer the dual advantage of technology enabled teaching as well as active student interaction. The use of smart boards offer teachers a positive learning experience by making teaching – learning and even evaluation exercises participatory. Smart boards facilitate the conduct of lectures via hybrid mode wherein experts from outside and

the industry can be invited to give lectures from their respective locations. Similarly, students who cannot attend sessions can also be invited to do so via the online mode. Importantly students from marginalized sections will be able to partake in a technology which is contemporary and essential to overall skill development.

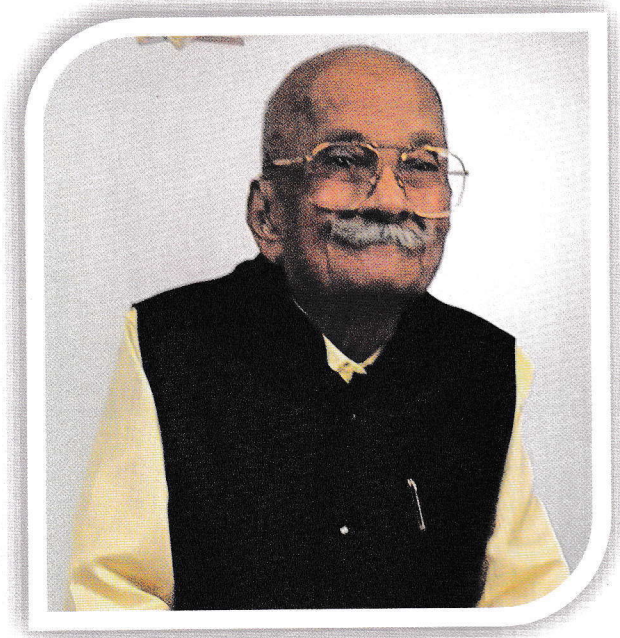

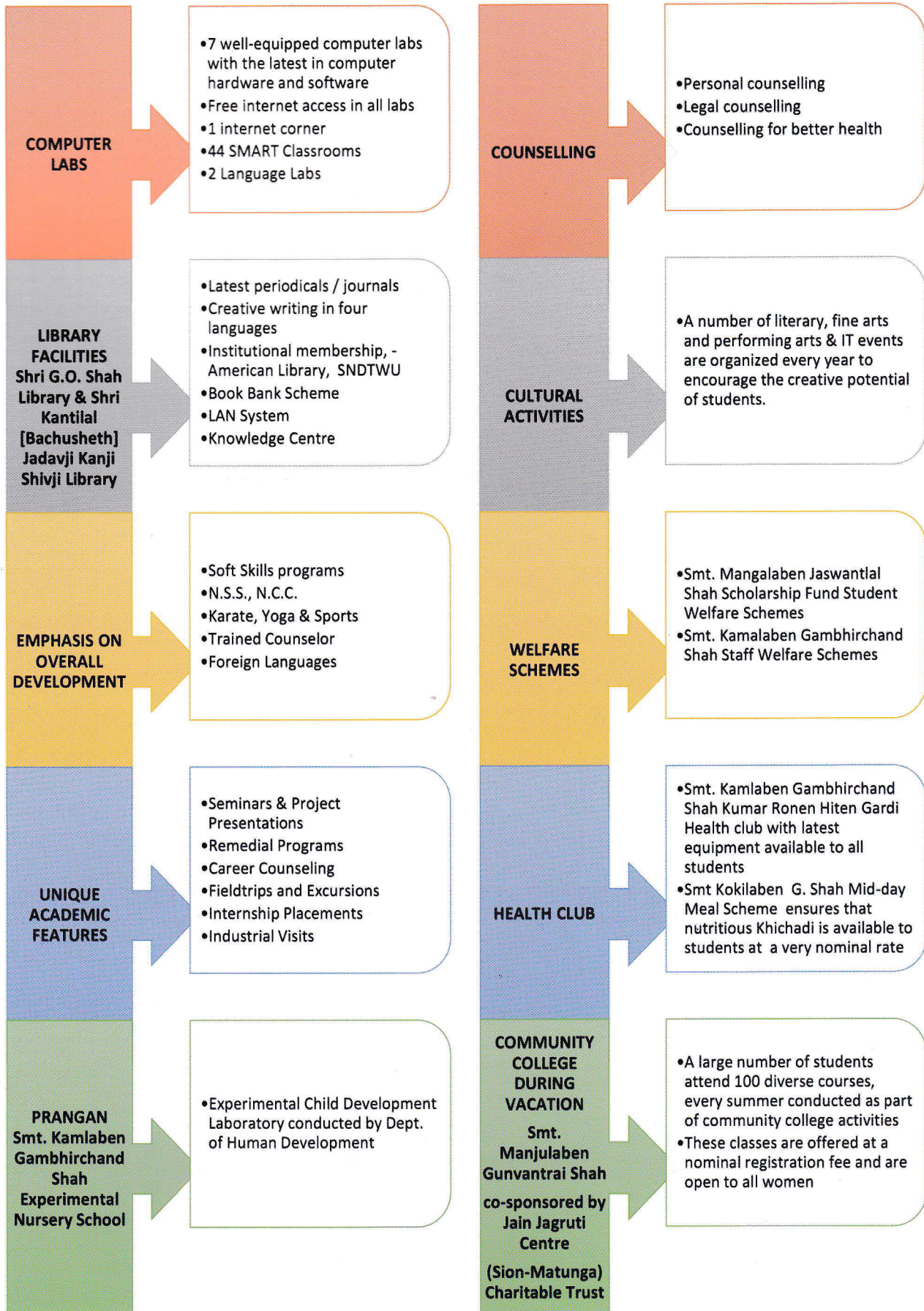

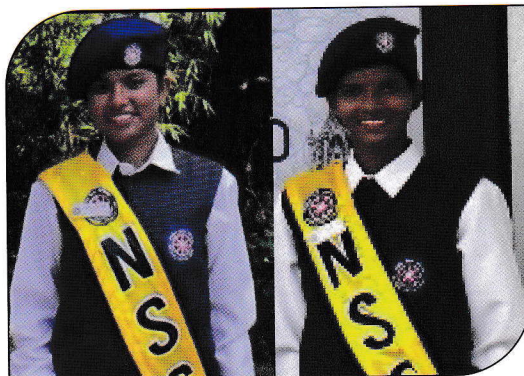
