a) **Role of Smt. Sunanda Pravin Gambhirchand College of Nursing, GNM School of Nursing, ANM School of Nursing and Paramedical science College.**

- Facilitate use of academic resources such as teachers, nursing students, nursing staff, library and laboratories.
- Planning and executing collaborative projects like medical checkup, health camps, blood donation camps, seminars, conferences, workshops, symposia, and competitions.
- Provide internship as per need of hospital and rotation of students in all departments for an all round experience.
- Conduct research activities which will facilitate institutional growth and to obtain permission from ethical committees to conduct research.
- Maintain quality standards and contribute in nursing care by using evidenced based practices.
- Co-ordination with nursing superintendent for clinical postings.
- Facilitate and provide services in times of acute shortage or social / natural emergencies.

b) **Role of Hospitals**

- Giving access to clinical field and helping them to understand the ward routine to facilitate independent practice in future.

- Utilizing expertise of nursing services.
- Students shall be given access in every area under the supervision of teachers.
- Providing scope for data collection for research, explore many such areas of nursing practice.
- Facilitating practical examinations and to co-operate with external examiners for effective conduction of practical exams and viva.
- Co-operation during Inspection and with inspectors for exchange of information.
- Sponsor vaccination, Health checkup, Blood Test, at subsidized rates.
