 3. Competition like Poster making, Logo making were also held for students and Essay competition was held for teaching and non-teaching staff in antiragging week.


AGENDA 6: Reporting of any complaints

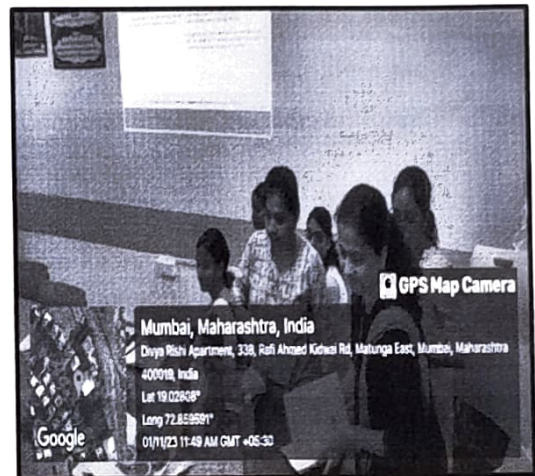
